

#### A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

# Prayer of St. Francis of Assisi (Prayer for Peace)

Lord, make me an instrument of your peace:

where there is hatred, let me sow love;

where there is injury, pardon;

where there is doubt, faith;

where there is despair, hope;

where there is darkness, light;

where there is sadness, joy.

O divine Master, grant that I may not so much seek

to be consoled as to console,

to be understood as to understand,

to be loved as to love.

For it is in giving that we receive,

it is in pardoning that we are pardoned,

and it is in dying that we are born to eternal life.

While this prayer is attributed to St. Francis (1181-1226), it was most likely penned by an anonymous author in France in the early twentieth century. The uncertainty of authorship does not diminish the power and appropriateness of the prayer.

I was recently reminded of the prayer and decided to revisit it. The words are simple, yet elegant. The prayer touches on the relationship we have with ourselves and with those around us. Ultimately, those relationships are reflective of God's love and presence.

We have all encountered hatred, injury, doubt, despair, darkness and sadness. Some of this, we have aimed toward ourselves for what we have done or have ignored to do. Guilt can be motivating in some instances, but it can also be a burden that crushes us. So, this peace may be granted to us through Jesus Christ. This gift of love, pardon, faith, hope, light and joy is ours because of God's love.

The Prayer of St. Francis is a request that God will use us to promote God's kingdom, God's way, in and to the world around us. May we be given the strength to share and exemplify the peace and love of God, "for it is in giving that we receive".

May this simple yet profound prayer guide your days. I have reintroduced the prayer in my devotional time. I invite you to do the same.
